DUAL TRACK SETTING

The Christ the Teacher School Division is committed to offering French Immersion in a dual track setting. This “dual track” philosophy ensures that French Immersion students and students in regular English programs learn from each other through school-wide activities.

NON-FRENCH SPEAKING STUDENTS

The French Immersion program is designed for non-French speaking students who wish to develop a high level of proficiency in both official languages. Students can start French Immersion at the grade 1 level.

Students in the Christ the Teacher French Immersion Programs learn the French language through an immersion process in a natural manner, much the same way as they learned to understand and speak their first language. They learn first to understand then to communicate and read.
