Facilities and Transportation Reports

CTTCS Director of Education Barb MacKesey and Chief Financial Officer Delmar Zwirsky presented the Board with reports regarding division facilities and student transportation. The facilities report provided an overview of current and projected utilization rates, a summary of maintenance costs, and maintenance projects completed in 2017-18.

The Student Transportation Report was presented to provide the Board an overview of the procedures and services available to students related to transportation. Of note, security cameras were installed on school buses that provide student transportation services within the cities of Melville and Yorkton in 2017-18.

2018-19 Enrolment Report

Director of Education Barb MacKesey presented the Enrolment Report, which includes the number of students enrolled in each school by grade and the numbers of students enrolled in home-based education as of September 30th of the current school year. Each year, in early October, the division verifies student enrolments with the Ministry of Education. Initial Student Enrolment verification was completed on October 4th, with Enrolment Finalization scheduled for October 19th. In 2018-19, the division Kindergarten to Grade 12 enrolment is 1758, which exceeded projections by 42 students. The division's total enrolment including Prekindergarten students (80) for the 2018-19 school year is 1838 students.
