Facilities Report

CTTCS Chief Financial Officer Delmar Zwirsky presented the Board with the division facilities report, which provided an overview of current utilization rates, a summary of maintenance costs, and maintenance projects completed in the 2024-25 school year.

Enrolment Report

Each year in October, Administration presents to the Board an Enrolment Report for information. The Enrolment Report includes the number of students enrolled in each school by grade and the number of students enrolled in home-based education by grade as of September 30th of the current school year. The projected enrolment for the 2025-26 school year was 1772 students (excluding prekindergarten). This year's enrolment of 1877 (excluding prekindergarten) exceeds projections by 105 students. The division's total enrolment including prekindergarten is currently 1963 students for the 2025-26 school year.

Saskatchewan Library Week

The week of October 12-18, 2025 was proclaimed as Saskatchewan Library Week, with the theme of "*Libraries Open Doors*".

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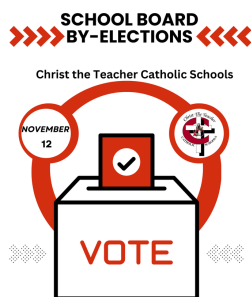

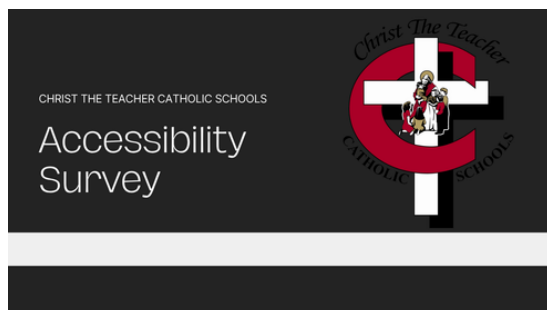
School Board By-election 2025
