

Congratulations to all students who competed in ECDAA & SHSAA Badminton and Track & Field championships this spring.




Outdoor Education

Earlier this Spring, St. Michael's School hosted a ceremony to open the school time capsule from 25 years ago. Thanks to alumni students and staff who were able to attend.




Treaty Education
