ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURES

SECTION: 300 - STUDENTS CODE: AP 300

PROCEDURE: STUDENT ENTRANCE AGE

BACKGROUND

There are a variety of entrance ages depending on the assessed education needs of the child.

PROCEDURES

- 1. Students must attain the age of five (5) years on or before the last day of December of the school year in which the student applies for admission to a Division kindergarten program.
 - 1.1 However, for children with identified special education needs, Early Childhood Services programs are available for children as young as two (2) years eight (8) months as of September 1 of a program year.
 - 1.2 Attendance in a Kindergarten program shall not be a pre-requisite to admission into the grade one program of the Division.
- 2. It is Division policy that only the following children will be accepted into grade one:
 - 2.1 Those children whose sixth (6th) birthday occurs on or before the last day of December in the calendar year following school opening;
 - 2.2 Children who have successfully completed kindergarten in another school jurisdiction shall be admitted to grade one regardless of age.

2.3 Beginning grade one students must enter in September of the school year.
