BACKGROUND

In order to meet the diverse needs of students, the Division may approve the provision of special programs.

PROCEDURES

- 1. For the purposes of this procedure, a special program is defined as one which demonstrates a significant difference in one or more of the following aspects of providing educational opportunities to students:
 - 1.1 Organizational structure;
 - 1.2 Curriculum;
 - 1.3 Method of instruction;
 - 1.4 Use of physical or human resources.

Such programs shall be consistent with the mission, vision, foundational values and goals of the Division, and shall meet the requirements of legislation.

- 2. Proposals for special programs shall be made to the Director/designate.
- 3. Prior to the implementation of an special program, the Director/designate shall:
 - 3.1 When required by legislation, submit proposed special programs to the Board for its approval.
 - 3.2 When required by legislation, submit those programs approved by the Board to the Minister of Education for approval.
- 4. The Director/designate is responsible for development of programs and the evaluation of special programs.
- 5. The Director/designate is responsible for monitoring the delivery and supervision of special programs.
