Second Quarter Fiscal Accountability Report

CTTCS Chief Financial Officer Delmar Zwirsky presented an interim financial update as of the end of the 2nd quarter of the 2025-26 fiscal year. The Statement of Financial Activities for the period ending February 28, 2026 indicates the division expenditures are on target with budgeted amounts at mid-year. The cash position of the Division remains stable to allow the Division to meet payment commitments.

2026-27 School Calendar

The 2026-27 school calendar, developed in collaboration with Good Spirit School Division, Good Spirit Teachers' Association, Christ the Teacher Catholic Schools, and the Christ the Teacher Teacher's Association was approved by the Board. 2025-26 Mid-Year Transportation Report

The purpose of this report is to provide background information and updates regarding urban bus services to date. CTTCS contracts urban bus services within the City of Melville (2 buses and 2 routes) and the City of Yorkton (4 buses and 4 routes).

CTTCS Chief Financial Officer Delmar Zwirsky shared with the Board that CTTCS provides urban transportation services to approximately 525 students in Melville and Yorkton. These services are provided by Southland Transportation Ltd. A transportation agreement exists with Good Spirit School Division, who transports rural students enrolled in CTTCS schools.

The report provided the Board with background information, as well as updates on the four key risk areas of: Driver Competence; Student Behaviour; Vehicle Maintenance / Condition; External Factors.



Good News in CTTCS

Alice Gregoire, lovingly nicknamed and known as "Moose" by many, is a talkative 7-year-old in Grade 2 at Dr. Bragg. She was born without an esophagus – a rare condition called Esophageal Atresia (EA) with Tracheoesophageal Fistula (TEF), Type C. Thus far, she has had 19 surgeries due to ongoing complications with her esophagus, lungs, and trachea, and was G-tube fed (feeding tube into her belly for all nutrition) for 1501 days while doctors worked to help her surgically constructed esophagus function. Her condition requires lifelong specialized care, and her chronic cough – though not contagious – is a result of her birth defect. Despite these challenges, Alice is full of joy. She loves cheerleading, dance, swimming, adores the colour pink, and dreams of becoming a nurse one day. Now an independent eater, the born-and-raised Yorkton girl proudly counts perogies as her favourite food.
