

# Religion Grade 8 Outcomes and Indicators

### Scripture and Church Teachings (ST)

#### **ST8.1 Determine the influence of the Holy Spirit within Christian living.**

ST8.1a Summarizes the Pentecost story from the Acts of the Apostles.

ST8.1b Appraises the significance of the impact of the Pentecost story on the apostles and the Christian community.

ST 8.1c Identifies and analyzes the gifts of Holy Spirit and the fruits of the Holy Spirit as a continuing presence of the Holy Spirit in our daily life.

#### **ST8.2 Analyze the role of the sacraments in Christian living.**

ST 8.2a Identifies and explain the seven sacraments.

ST 8.2b Develops an understanding of the signs, symbols and scriptural basis of the seven sacraments.

ST 8.2c Analyzes how each sacrament leads us to live out God's loving and saving action in our life.

ST 8.3a Understands the meaning and challenge of each statement of the Creed as studied.

## **Prayer and Celebration (PC)**

### **PC 8.1 Engage in the prayer life of the school and classroom.**

PC 8.1b Demonstrates an understanding of prayer's purpose through actively participating in prayer.

## **Witness (W)**

### **W8.1 Examine the various influences that impact our relationship with God.**
