PROCEDURE:	ORGANIZATION FOR INSTRUCTION		

BACKGROUND

The Principal is held accountable for organizing the school program in a manner consistent with the Education Act and all requirements of provincial regulation and Core Curriculum. The Principal is therefore charged with the responsibility for ensuring that these requirements reflect actual practice in that school.

PROCEDURES

1. The Principal, in consultation with staff, shall develop a school plan that clearly outlines the:
 - 1.1 Organization of classes;
 - 1.2 Organization of teacher assignments;
 - 1.3 Course offerings of the school; and
 - 1.4 Extracurricular and co-curricular activities.
