ANNUAL DECLARATION OF POTENTIALLY CONFLICTING INTERESTS

Any exceptions to the above are stated below with a full description of the transactions and of the interest, whether direct or indirect, which I have in the persons or organizations having transactions with the Christ the Teacher Catholic School Division.
