## **BACKGROUND**

The Division is committed to providing an environment which promotes good citizenship and respect of our Catholic values. The Principal, staff members, clergy, parents/guardians, volunteers, and students will recite/pray/reflect or listen to Catholic prayers, gospels, songs, poems, Bible readings, and creative writings that reflect the teachings of Christ in our faith community during opening exercises and/or closing exercises and/or selected assemblies.

## **PROCEDURES**

- 1. As the Faith leader in the school community, it is the responsibility of the Principal to ensure that opening exercises contain a reading or prayer reflective of our Catholic Faith Community. The Principal may delegate the conducting of the reading or prayer to one or more staff members or students.
- 2. Opening Exercises in all schools shall include:
  - 2.1 A classroom or school-wide directed reading or prayer reflective of our Catholic Faith Community; and,

2.2 The playing/singing of O' Canada.
