BACKGROUND

The development of pride in our country and respect and knowledge of our national symbols is a foundational value of the Christ the Teacher Catholic Schools.

PROCEDURES

- 1. Participation in and exposure to patriotic exercises is important in the development of a student's positive civic attitude and a love of our country. It addition it contributes to the development of good citizenship. A form of patriotic exercise may be included as part of opening exercises in the classroom.
- 2. The singing/playing of our national anthem is a required activity in our schools.
- 3. The Director may direct schools to lower flags in accordance with accepted protocols. Requests to have flags lowered at individual schools are to be made to the Director.
- 4. Opportunities to promote patriotism shall be found in the appropriate curriculum areas to develop in our students, knowledge of Canada and a sense of pride in our country.

5. The flag of Canada shall be prominently displayed inside and outside the school building.
