BACKGROUND

The development of pride in our country and respect and knowledge of our national symbols is a foundational value of the Christ the Teacher Catholic Schools.

PROCEDURES

1. Participation in and exposure to patriotic exercises is important in the development of a student's positive civic attitude and a love of our country. In addition it contributes to the development of good citizenship. A form of patriotic exercise may be included as part of opening exercises in the classroom.
2. The singing/playing of our national anthem is a required activity in our schools.
3. The Director may direct schools to lower flags in accordance with accepted protocols. Requests to have flags lowered at individual schools are to be made to the Director.
4. Opportunities to promote patriotism shall be found in the appropriate curriculum areas to develop in our students, knowledge of Canada and a sense of pride in our country.
5. The flag of Canada shall be prominently displayed inside and outside the school building.
