The **Soup Haven Lunch Program** was established in 1997 with a mission to provide nutritious lunches to all school children in need in Good Spirit and Christ the Teacher school divisions because education and proper nutrition go hand in hand.

The new cargo van is safer and more efficient for picking up supplies and making deliveries to the schools. The kitchen appliances and small storage items have also improved the efficiency and safety during daily preparation of lunches for students.
